Although sports are traditionally competitive, Legion Sports are primarily for the Comradeship.

If you register for an event and are unable to make it, be sure to notify the Saskatchewan Command as soon as possible, and they'll contact the host branch. You may be required to pay for host fees and provincial fees if cancelling after the deadline.
